SHOW RULES

- 1. The Show Committee and/or Judge(s) reserve the right to excuse any exhibitor and/or horse showing unsafe behavior, lameness, unsportsmanlike conduct towards other horses, exhibitors or show staff.
- 2. Martingales will be allowed in all classes.
- 3. Draw reins are allowed only in Novice Horse.
- 4. Tie-downs, mechanical hackamores or any other illegal equipment is **NOT** allowed in any class. If you are unsure about your equipment ask the show office.
- 5. Stallions may be shown (see rule 1).
- 6. Hats and boots are required.
- 7. Proper show attire is recommended.
- 8. Helmets are required in leadline classes but may be worn in any class.
- 9. Leadline riders must have feet in stirrups. The lead may NOT be attached to the bit.
- 10. Classes may be combined, split or cancelled as needed.
- 11. Riders with open checks or credit cards can add class as the gate. All other entries must be made at least 2 classes in advance in the show office.
- 12. Entries may be emailed before the show or taken in the show office day of the show.
- 13. Open checks, cash or credit cards accepted. Service fee of 5% added to all credit card payments.
- 14. Office opens one hour before the show begins.
- 15. Scratched classes must be taken in the show office.

HIGH POINT RULES

- *No minimum shows required
- *Exhibitor will select which HP they are competing for at the first show attended
- *Points will not transfer between W/T & canter/Lope classes
- *Riders who show canter/lope may enter W/T but only for schooling; will not be placed
- *Points earned in open classes will apply to age appropriate HP
- *Youth riders (18 & Under) cannot ride in classes specified as 19 & Over
- *In-hand classes count toward chosen HP
- *Points are earned by the rider on all horses being shown
- * Riders can work towards all HP championships
- *Points are calculated by the number of entries in a class: 6 in the maximum number of points per class.

For example, in a classes of 6 or more horses:

- 1 = 6 points
- 2 = 5 points
- 3 = 4 points
- 4 = 3 points
- 5 = 2 points
- 6 = 1 point

- 16. Refunds given at the discretion of show mgt.
- 17. No alcoholic beverages on show premises.
- 18. All exhibitors must be off the show grounds 1 hour after completion of show.
- 19. USEF Rules followed as much as possible.
- 20 Trail may not be offered at all shows.

DEFINITIONS

WALK/TROT: riders not entered into lope/cantor classes, exception if schooling ride will not be judged or count towards Walk/Trot high points.

NOVICE HORSE: has not won more than 3 blue ribbons in that performance division.

AGE DIVISIONS: Age of rider on January 1st.
